

West Hampton Swimming Pool Rules (2024)

All Association Members:

This is your pool facility. It is the responsibility of all association members to abide by and enforce the rules.

This pool is a '**SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK**' facility.

LIFEGUARD ON DUTY

Lifeguards, when provided, are there for safety purposes.

1. Lifeguards MUST BE ABLE TO SEE THE BOTTOM OF THE POOL at all times. Use of floats is at the discretion of the lifeguard.
2. Lifeguards have the final say on enforcement of pool rules.
3. Verbal/Physical abuse of lifeguards will result in immediate expulsion from the pool area and is subject to loss of amenities privileges.
4. Children aged 10 and older who can swim unassisted and without the use of flotation devices, may swim unattended only when a lifeguard is on duty.
5. Children aged 15 and younger must exit completely out of the pool during lifeguard breaks unless swimming with an adult. (two children per adult maximum)

NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY

Children aged 16 and younger must be accompanied, on the pool deck, by a responsible person over the age of 18.

AT ALL TIMES

1. Members must be in good standing with the WHHOA to use any community amenity.
2. Swimming attire only. NO jeans or street clothes allowed.
3. Maximum of FIVE (5) guests per household are allowed.
4. Residents (18 and over) MUST accompany their guests at all times
5. Threatening, offensive, or foul language is not permitted and may result in immediate expulsion from the pool area
6. Children 9 years and younger must be accompanied by an adult (18 or older)
7. Incontinent people MUST ALWAYS wear swim diapers and proper swim garments

NO: Running, Pets, Glass, Smoking/Vaping in pool area

NO: Tennis balls or non-pool specific balls allowed within the pool area.

NO: Diving in shallow end of pool.

NO: Open cuts/sores; spitting; blowing nose in pool

NO: Food or Drink of ANY KIND in the pool.

NO: Wheeled transport (roller skates, hee-lies, skateboards, etc). Wheelchairs, baby strollers/carriages are allowed.

DO NOT PROP OPEN THE GATE!

This is a safety/liability issue.

Exception: Swim Team personnel or pool maintenance personnel.

Violation of pool rules may result in fines and immediate loss of all West Hampton amenity privileges.
